A Second Round of Tryouts will be held on April 26th if needed.

Players must register for the tryout in advance. This is a once a year opportunity to represent your state and compete at the highest level against players from across the country representing their states. There will be multiple media and exposure companies covering the event. If you are registering and you know of a player that should be a part of what we are doing, please get them involved or have them contact us to help them.

\$10 NSID registration Fee is Due ASAP, after tryouts.

\$180 is due in full ASAP, after tryouts. NO EXCEPTIONS

The NSID is the company that will verify that players are playing in the correct age division. For this event a player plays in the age division that they are currently aged to. So, if you are 12 on August 6th and turn 13 on August 7th, 8th or 9th you would play in 13U. You play in whatever age division as you are old when the event is happening, or you play up. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to playing down an age. This will not interfere with any summer club basketball or plans that you have with them. Your practices will be organized around and after the club the ball ends in July. To then get ready for the event prior to traveling.

Remember this is to represent the State of Colorado and play with some amazing kids from our state. This is not an opportunity to recruit or steal kids from other organizations. This type of behavior will not be allowed and any coaches attempting to do so will be removed from the staff.
